Step 1: Make a cardboard planter

Using the cardboard and glue/stapler (or tape), cut a piece of cardboard and construct a cylindrical or cube-shaped planter. You can glue (or tape) a cut sheet of paper or a piece of cardboard for the bottom.



Step 2: Draw and cut out leaves

Fold the green cardstock in half. Take the cardstock and draw out your desired leaf shape. Then cut out.



Step 3: Glue/Staple/Tape leaves to the inside of the planter



Step 4: Add crumpled brown tissue paper to the inside of the planter to make the base more stable and decorate the plant!
