GOLDEN TRIANGLE CREATIVE DISTRICT

The city's most iconic cultural destinations will be just steps away from our hotel; and our stops will include impressive museums such as the Denver Art Museum and the Clyfford Still Museum, and the Walker Fine Art Gallery. We'll also venture to lower downtown Denver to take in the Museum of Contemporary Art Denver.

ARTS DISTRICT ON SANTA FE

We'll venture to the nationally recognized Arts District on Santa Fe for Third Friday Collector's Night. The Arts District on Santa Fe has one of the highest densities of art galleries in the country and proudly honors the neighborhood's rich, Latino heritage, and supports the creativity of artists today.

RINO ART DISTRICT

Formerly an industrial center, now every nook and cranny of the River North (RiNo) neighborhood oozes with color and vibrancy. The day will feature an outdoor walking tour, a guided tour of the RedLine Contemporary Art Center with a peek into resident artist studios, and time to discover various galleries and shops in this vibrant neighborhood.

SPACE IS LIMITED

The remaining amount will be due on May 5, 2023. There is a minimum requirement of travelers, so please hold off on securing transportation (flights) until receiving final confirmation from Art Center – expected by mid-March. If the traveler threshold is not met, there may be an additional supplement.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

As noted above, a \$500/person non-refundable deposit is required to secure your reservation. Additionally, once full trip fees have been paid, fees are non-refundable. The tour price is based on 15 travelers. If fewer than 15 participate, a price supplement may apply. As a benefit of membership, invitation to this trip is first extended to travelers at the Ambassador level and above. If the trip does not fill by March 13, the opportunity will be extended to all Art Center members and donors.

ROOM PREFERENCE

The number of rooms with two beds is limited and will be reserved on a first come / first-serve basis.
